

32 Gift of Prophecy: A modern Miracle Revealed

Most Christian churches have understood that the gift of prophecy ceased with the death of the twelve apostles of Jesus. The New Testament is the last of God's revelations to man, they say.

But now a change has come. Millions of members of various churches have wondered about modern prophets and their prophecies. Every time some modern "prophet" makes a prediction that turns out right people wonder, "Has God restored the gift of prophecy to the Christian church again?"

For decades, the claims of Mary Baker Eddy as a prophetess have been advocated by some, while others have maintained that Joseph Smith was a true prophet. Side by side with this tremendous modern interest in prophecies comes a revival of ancient astrology. People everywhere are looking for a link with the supernatural. Astrology and the screaming tabloids have seemed to supply what is wanted.

We shall study first of all what the Bible says about the gift of prophecy—is it indeed a gift that ended with the apostles, or is it a gift that God will restore to us in the last days? Then we shall study how we may distinguish between a true prophet and a false prophet. Finally we shall consider how important this gift is, and how our eternal salvation depends on correctly relating ourselves to a true prophetic message that God sends.

The Miracle of the Genuine Gift of Prophecy in the Last Days The time has at last come when a true prophet is being recognized publicly. You may have noticed in these lessons quotations from several helpful books such as Happiness Digest, The Desire of Ages, and The Ministry of Healing. These were written by Ellen G. White, who was called to the work of a prophet in 1844, the time when the 2300-year prophecy of Daniel 8:14 met its final fulfillment. Until her death at 87 in 1915, this messenger of God did the work and bore the fruits of genuineness. Never did her teachings vary from the acid test of Holy Scripture. Her last words uttered in a large public meeting were: "I commend to you this Book [the Bible]." Her life and writings "edified" (built up) the church, strengthened the ministry, glorified Christ, led to the "perfecting of the saints." Millions testify to the value of her writings in leading them closer to the Lord. Also a vast worldwide movement embracing schools, hospitals, universities, publishing houses, and even a medical school, are the direct fruit of her life of service and her revelations from the Lord. If we apply Jesus' test to her, "By their fruits ye shall know them," we find abundant evidence that her call was indeed a genuine one. But you need not take anyone's word for it. You can taste and see for yourself-read Happiness Digest, The Desire of Ages, The Great Controversy, The Ministry of Healing, Education, or any one of scores of books from her pen. You will discover on every page the unmistakable imprint of divine inspiration. 11. The writings of Ellen G. White, as the "testimony of Jesus," often bring reproof. But there is always healing as well. We are constantly pointed to the Lamb of God, who takes away sin. Read 1 Corinthians 2:1, 2 and see how this truth of the cross is uplifted in the Spirit of Prophecy writings:

"If sinners can be led to give one earnest look at the cross, if they can obtain a full view of the crucified Saviour, they will realize the depth of God's compassion and the sinfulness of sin.

"Christ's death proves God's great love for man. It is our pledge of salvation. To remove the cross from the Christian would be like blotting the sun from the sky.
